DISCOVER

- 1 Piedras Blancas Light Station** 1874
Hike back in time to the life of a lighthouse keeper and learn about the past.
- 2 Hearst Castle** 1865
Tour the historic "Enchanted Hill" named by William Randolph Hearst.
- 3 San Simeon Bay Pier** 1800's
Visit one of the first piers that was used during the Spanish & Mexican eras.
Sebastian's General Store & Old San Simeon Village 1852
The Sebastian brothers provided goods and services to whalers, fishermen, miners and ranchers.
- 4 Cambria Historic Buildings Walking Tour** 1865
Time travel by walking from the museum to 28 preserved historic sights.
Cambria Historical Museum 1870
You're welcome to visit one of Cambria's oldest historic homes.
Santa Rosa Chapel & Cambria Cemetery 1870
Visit the first church in San Luis Obispo County.
Nitt Witt Ridge 1928
Explore the fun, crazy, artistic California Historic Landmark.
- 5 Harmony Dairy & Town** 1869
Visit Harmony (population 18) named for a symbol of truce after a long standing feud between dairy owners and ranchers.
- 6 Cayucos Pier** 1872
Stroll down the historic Cayucos Pier constructed by Captain James Cass, the founder of Cayucos.
Cass House 1867-1875
Enjoy the town's show place and social center during the late 1800's.

- 7 Spooner Ranch House, Montaña de Oro** 1892
Visit the museum with spectacular views overlooking Smuggler's Cove.
- 8 Point San Luis Lighthouse** 1890
Explore the active light station designed by architect Paul J. Pelz.
- 9 Hoosegow Jailhouse** 1910
Visit the lonesome, tiny one-room jailhouse.
Swinging Bridge 1875
Enjoy a stroll over the Arroyo Grande Creek on one of California's only swinging bridges.
Santa Manuela Schoolhouse 1901
Visit the School House's hand-on museum.
Paulding History House 1889
View the only authentic Chumash Indian basket in the county.
- 10 Oceano Historic Train Depot** 1904
Tour a turn-of-the-century train depot and railroad equipment.
- 11 Rancho Nipomo Historical Dana Adobe** 1840
Visit the cultural, historical 13-room adobe, built by Captain William Dana along the El Camino Real Stagecoach route.
