The trail through the lush coastal plains of Harmony Headlands State Park turns a corner to reveal a 180-degree view of rugged coastline.

### 11. Walk the Beach:

Locals love to walk the 12 miles between Cayucos State Beach and Morro Rock for a heart-pumping workout.



### 12. Just Bluffing:

Cruise the Bluff Trail Hike at Montaña de Oro, a 4-mile hike that looks over high cliffs to the ocean.



### 13. Horsing Around:

One of the largest free range herds of Clydesdales roams the Covell Ranch – enjoy a trail ride through the ranch's expansive stand of Monterey Pines.



### 14. With the Greatest of Ease:

Tour the skies above Oceano with an adrenaline-filled aerobatic biplane ride.



### 15. Over, Under, Around and Through:

Strap in and hang on: A Humvee tour of the Ocean Dunes is a thrill not for the faint of heart.



### 16. Flippers, Fins and Tails:

Whether you book a whale watching tour or just hang out on the beach, chances are good you'll see a spout offshore.

Visit the Piedras Blancas Elephant Seal Rookery and watch their antics in one of the world's best viewing spots.
